






# The four key functions of the NSW Reconstruction Authority

### NSW RA Regional Delivery

- Ensure service delivery to local communities balances consistency with regional context
- Deliver on-ground recovery service's to impacted communities in partnership with other divisions and stakeholders
- Support and guidance to councils and government agencies
- Local coordination and support to services
- Local support in disaster resilience, risk reduction, adaptation and mitigation activities
- Local engagement and planning with key stakeholders to assist in the delivery of recovery services and the development of Local Pre-Event Recovery Plans



### Recovery Initiatives

- Supporting the continued operations of the Lismore Recovery Centre
- Leading and or attending local recovery committees






















### Purpose of a Community Resilience Network





Brings together organisations that are not represented on the LEMC or Recovery Committee



Enabling participation of community service organisations and local NGOs in recovery planning and resilience building for their communities



It provides a communications link for emergency managers to expert advice on community needs and capabilities



Bring specialist knowledge and insights about the needs and characteristics of the local community, particularly client groups who are often those most vulnerable to the immediate and longer-term impacts of disaster events

### How can the Purpose be Achieved



- Advising the LEMC and Council on disaster recovery and resilience issues affecting human and social wellbeing matters within the Ballina Shire Council (LGA)
- Sharing disaster recovery related information affecting human and social wellbeing issues, and assisting with needs and capacity assessments following a disaster event
- Assisting in informing the wider community of recovery operations and engaging the community in the recovery process
- Support the Local Recovery Committee (if established) to enhance recovery activities and information sharing following a disaster event
- Informing recovery planning, vulnerabilities assessments and input into social profiles



### The Network



- Membership of the CRN is informed by the local community profile and should represent the range of government and non-government organisations represented that would contribute to human and social wellbeing recovery of the community following a disaster.
- Efforts can be made to invite emergency services community engagement personnel (if available) as guests to CRN meetings. These community engagement personnel act as direct conduits back to emergency service agencies and can also support local efforts in organising activities in the preparedness and response space.


